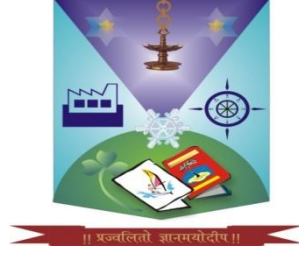
OBJECTIVE	The aim of this event is to celebrating Republic Day.

Shirwadkar, popularly known as 'Kusumagraj' on Tuesday, 27th February, 2024 at 12.00pm. Prof. Heena Ansari welcomed all the faculty members and students. Prof. Gaurav Mohite stated that the Government started celebrating the birth anniversary of Kusumagraj as 'Marathi Rajbhasha Gaurav Din' after the Jnanpeeth awardee's demise in 1999. From this year, it has instituted two special awards for individuals taking initiatives to promote Marathi literature. The first 'Bhasha Samwardhak' award went to an Ahmednagar-based vegetable vendor, Bebitai Gaikwad, who saved Rs 5 per day from her earnings to purchase 900 books. A high school drop-out, Bebitai claims to have read more than 3,000 books on Marathi literature till date."

Mr. Abhishek Shelar FYBCom(A & F) expressed his views about Kusumagraj and shared his experiences with all the students and faculty members. Prof. Gaurav Mohite encouraged students to improve their Marathi communication and learning skills. Students were impressed by his speech. Mr. Aditya Gaikwad and Ms. Rutika Patil student of FYBSc.IT read popular poems of V. V.

Shirwadkar. Students from SYBSc.IT prepared Marathi Poems, Popular Marathi Articles or Marathi slogans beautifully. Program was concluded by the vote of Thanks given by Mr.Anil Jadhav.
